What is Hyperlink?

HTML links are hyperlinks. You can click on a link and jump to another document. When you move the mouse over a link, the mouse arrow will turn into a little hand. A hyperlink is an element in an HTML document that links to either another portion of the document or to another document altogether.

A link does not have to be text. A link can be an image or any other HTML elements. The HTML <a> tag defines a hyperlink.

By default, links will appear as follows in all browsers:

- An unvisited link is underlined and blue
- A visited link is underlined and purple
- An active link is underlined and red

HTML Links - The target attribute

By default, the linked page will be displayed in the current browser window. To change this, you must specify another target for the link.

The target attribute can have one of the following values:

_self - Default. Opens the document in the same window/tab as it was clicked

_blank - Opens the document in a new window or tab

parent - Opens the document in the parent frame

_top - Opens the document in the full body of the window

HTML Hyperlink Types.

Links are used to "link" a visitor from one area to another. There are three types of links:


- 1. Local or Relative: A page on the same server or directory
- 2. *Internal:* A section on the current page or document
- 3. External or Absolute: A page or site on a different server or directory


